The Spartanburg County Public Libraries experienced power outages, minor water intrusions, and a few downed trees.

Today, Tuesday, October 1, we have opened the Downtown/Headquarters Library. We will remain open from 10 to 4. Reading material, public computers and printing are available. USB ports have been disabled. This is a step to protect the computer network.
